PERENNIAL LIFECYCLE & TREATMENT TIMING

ROOT WRENCH Attach root wrench to sapling and pull roots out.

HERBICIDE Foliar spray leaves, and lower 18" of bark with herbicide.

CUT AND TREAT Cut shrub at the base and spray outer rings.

FORESTRY MOW Cut, grind and clear vegetation. Follow up with other treatments.

PRESCRIBED FIRE Burn seedlings and saplings

GRAZING Goats or sheep eat foliage and bark.

Monitoring and repeated management is necessary for long term control of established infestations.
