

## SPOTTED KNAPWEED Centaurea stoebe ssp. micranothos

## PERENNIAL LIFECYCLE & TREATMENT TIMING

HAND PULL Remove roots of small infestations.





**MOW** Mow at least once per year during flowering stage.

**FOLIAR SPRAY** Spray rosettes or bolting plants.

**BIOCONTROL** Release designated biocontrol agents on large populations.



**GRAZING** Goats or sheep eat at rosette stage and bolting stage.

Monitoring and repeated management is necessary for long term control of established infestations.
